TRANSPORTATION OPTIONS FOR ALASKA BUSINESS WEEK

Transportation to and from Fairbanks is not provided as part of the Alaska Business Week registration fee. However, due to the generous contributions of our sponsors, limited transportation assistance is now available.

Alaska Business Week will provide free shuttle service from the Fairbanks International Airport and the Fairbanks Alaska Railroad Depot. We also suggest carpooling/traveling with other students from your school/area. **Students should arrive at the UAF campus no later than 12:00 p.m. on Sunday, August 8th.** Registration is from 10:30 a.m. – 12:30 p.m.

AIR –
Era Alaska is providing **20 free round-trip tickets** to qualifying students from communities served on their routes outside of Anchorage. Alaska Business Week will award these tickets.

Era Alaska is also offering a **25% discount** to Alaska Business Week participants from Era Alaska served communities on **Era Aviation, Frontier Flying Service, or Hageland Flying Service.**

All reservations for discounted tickets must be made directly with Era Alaska at 1-800-866-8394. Passengers must reference Event ID Number ABW10 to receive the event fare. Tickets are valid for one year from date of original outbound travel. Travel that occurs outside of the travel dates of August 7-14 will require an upgrade to the applicable fare.

FARES: A discount of 25% off all fares, excluding companion, excursion or promotional fares. Space is to be booked in the same class of service as the fare being discounted and is based on availability. All fare rules apply.

ROUTING: This fare is valid for participants attending the 2010 Alaska Business Week to be held in Fairbanks, Alaska. The fare is valid from any Era Alaska (Era, Frontier or Hageland) served city to Fairbanks, and is directional.

RESERVATIONS: All reservations must be made directly with Era Alaska at 1-800-866-8394. Passengers must reference Event ID Number ABW10 to receive the event fare. Tickets are valid for one year from date of original outbound travel. Travel that occurs outside of the above travel dates will require an upgrade to the applicable fare.

The train will depart from Anchorage early morning **Saturday, August 7th**. The return train departs Fairbanks early morning **Saturday, August 14th**. Students will be contacted with additional information on the train logistics when they request a free ticket.
