



Statement from the Alaska Support Industry Alliance, Alaska Chamber of Commerce, and Alaska Oil and Gas Association in response to the Senate's version of the gasoline bill:

We are extremely disappointed to see new taxes added to legislation intended to advance the gasoline. Last week, the Alaska House provided a strong bipartisan path forward when they passed a bill that focused on the project itself without unrelated tax increases. Major energy projects require stable, competitive policies that attract investment, and we hope the focus returns to advancing Alaska's energy future rather than increasing taxes on the very companies needed to invest in Alaska.
